AS9100 Rev. C Internal Auditor

Course Description

This 2-day course is designed to provide a working understanding of the requirements for a QMS based upon SAE AS 9100 REV C. It will prepare internal auditors to perform effective process audits under the auspices of AS 9100 and prepare managers/supervisors to take full advantage of the internal audit process.

Students will gain an understanding of the requirements of AS 9100, its inter-relationship with other elements of the AS 9100 family of standards and the base, ISO 9001:2008. It is a mixture of tutorial and practical exercises, which are designed to provide practical help and guidance for Internal Auditors, who are preparing to implement, maintain or improve an internal audit program.

Learning Objectives

- Understand effective internal auditing to the AS 9100 family of standards.
- Interpret the differences between AS 9100 Rev C and ISO 9001:2008.
- Understand the systems that must be in place to satisfy AS9100 Rev. C and ISO 19011:2011.
- Understand the perspective of the 3rd party auditor.

- Internal Auditor Program Manager
- Members of the audit team
- Any manager/supervisor who wishes to implement, maintain or improve an effective internal audit process.

Prerequisite

There are no formal prerequisites, but experience in aerospace and/or ISO 9001:2008, AS9100 Rev A or B internal auditing would be beneficial. Participants should have a basic "understanding" of the AS9100 standard requirements.
