

CEMS 07 - Comprehensive Emergency Management System

Course Description:

CEMS 07 is a Comprehensive Emergency Management System designed to bring together, in one system, the efforts and information on specific requirements that need to be covered during a disaster or emergency plan or program.

An effective emergency management plan will:

- Promote the safety of workers, responders and the public.
- Reduce the potential for costly damage.
- Reduce environmental and other impacts.
- Assist emergency staff in initiating corrective actions.
- Reduce recovery time and associated costs.
- Ensure employee and public confidence in your organization's ability to manage crisis.

Learning Objectives:

Participants will gain a thorough understanding of how to complete a Comprehensive Emergency Management System to allow “self declaration” by the organization of having an effective and comprehensive Emergency Management System in place. The system provides requirements to support International standards, should they be developed in the future.
