

OHSAS 18001:2007 and CSA Z1000-06 Internal Auditor

Course Description:

This course provides the knowledge, competencies and skills required to audit an Occupational Health & Safety Management System that meets the requirements of the OHSAS 18001:2007 and CSA Z1000-06 standards. Participants will review the requirements of the OHSAS 18001:2007 and CSA Z1000-06 requirements, and learn the skills and techniques required to participate as a member of an auditing team.

Learning Objectives:

Through presentation, discussion and group exercises, participants will:

- Understand the requirements presented by the OHSAS 18001:2007 and CSA Z1000-06 standards.
- Know and appreciate the requirements for procedures, work instructions, process improvement plans and other supporting documentation.
- Understand methods for hazard identification and risk assessment.
- Appreciate the roles and responsibilities of the Auditor.
- Apply the concepts and guidelines detailed in ISO 19011:2011 when performing an audit.
- Practice all phases of an internal audit including using checklists, running meetings and writing reports.
- Develop the necessary communication skills, leadership skills and attitudes to perform an internal audit.

Who Should Attend:

- Staff responsible for documenting management system processes.
- Staff who, as part of their responsibilities, carry out the audit function.
- Any individual interested in managing or participating in an internal audit.

Prerequisite:

Participants should have a basic working knowledge of OHSAS 18001:2007 and/or CSA Z1000-06, or should have experience working within an Occupational Health & Safety Management System.
