

Understanding & Implementing AS9100 Rev. C

Course Description

This 2-day course is designed to provide a working understanding of the requirements for a QMS based upon SAE/AS 9100 Revision C. Students will gain an understanding of the requirements of AS 9100, its inter-relationship with other elements of the AS 9100 family of standards and the base, ISO 9001:2008. There is also a variety of discussion focused on the practical activities and considerations required for successful implementation of the standard in an organization.

Learning Objectives

- Understand the clauses and specific requirements of the AS9100 Rev. C standard.
- Interpret the differences between AS 9100 Rev. C and ISO 9001:2008.
- Understand the systems that must be in place within the organization to satisfy AS9100 Rev C.

Who Should Attend

- Managers or supervisors responsible for implementing at AS9100 Rev. C Quality Management System.
- Employees who will be working on, or within the structure of, and AS9100 Rev. C QMS.
- Anyone that has responsibilities to upgrade their AS9100 system requirements from Rev B to Rev C.
