

Understanding & Implementing ISO 31000:2009

Course Description:

This course is designed primarily to provide the basic knowledge & understanding of the key elements of ISO 31000:2009 - Risk Management – Principles & Guidelines.

Participants will learn how to implement the standard & integrate risk management into an organization's governance & management systems. The course discussion covers the new structure of the ISO 31000 family of standards, the risk management framework and processes, as well as the 11 risk management principles upon which the standard is based.

Learning Objectives:

- Understand the guidelines & principles of ISO 31000:2009 – Risk Management to effectively implement a risk management program in your organization.
- Review risk management as a concept including discussion about positive & negative outcomes.
- Learn about other risk management standards, terminology and definition of risk.
- Understand principles for managing risk, the importance of mandate & commitment from senior management, key components of framework design & critical success factors.
- Learn about implementation, monitoring review, continual improvement & governance of the risk management framework.
