

Understanding & Implementing RC14001:2008

Course Description:

To ensure an understanding of ISO 14001:2004 Standard and the additional elements required by the RC14001:2008 technical specification, and to provide guidance that will help clarify and simplify what is needed to implement a practical working RC14001:2008 environmental management system in a variety of production and service environments.

- Understand each of the specific requirements of the ISO 14001:2004 standard.
- Understand the additional elements required by the RC14001:2008 technical specification.
- Practice the skills required to identify & rank environmental impacts, set targets and objectives, and mitigate risks.
- Learn the general steps in the implementation of an Environmental Management System.
- Understand the expected improvements that result from an implemented EMS.
- Gain an introductory knowledge of the importance of an ongoing internal audit program.

Anyone in the organization responsible for implementing, managing and maintaining the RC14001:2008 Environmental Management System or anyone who expects to have significant involvement in support of these activities.

This is an introductory course intended for those with little or no experience in environmental management systems. No previous experience is required.
